

How's Your Testimony?

Hebrews 11:5 KJV

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Points to Consider:

Is Your Testimony Pleasing to God?

1. We Are Commanded To Know God's Testimonies.

Psalm 119:125 (New American Standard Bible)

"I am Your servant; give me understanding, That I may know Your testimonies."

2. We Are Blessed When We Keep God's Testimonies.

Psalm 119:2 (KJV)

"Blessed are they that keep his testimonies and that seek him with the whole heart."

3. God's Testimonies Are Given In The Commandments.

Exodus 25:16 (Amplified Bible)

"And you shall put inside the ark the Testimony [the Ten Commandments] which I give you."

Exodus 31:18 (New American Standard Bible)

"When He had finished speaking with him upon Mount Sinai, He gave Moses the two tablets of the testimony, tablets of stone, written by the finger of God."

(see also Ex.20:1-17)

4. Jesus Gives The Ultimate Testimony Of God.

John 1:17-18 (KJV)

"For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. No man hath seen God at any time, the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him."

John 14:9 (New American Standard Bible)

“Jesus said to him, “Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”

5. We Are Commanded To Live Holy As Our Testimony.

1 Peter 1:14-16 (New American Standard Bible)

“As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; because it is written, “YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY.”

6. Our Lives Are To Be A Light Giving Testimony Of God.

Matthew 5:14-16 (Amplified Bible)

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a peck measure, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men that they may see your moral excellence and your praiseworthy, noble, and good deeds and recognize and honor and praise and glorify your Father Who is in heaven.”
